3.	KART RETRIEVAL
3.1.	Pit Crew with trolleys Will Not be given access to the Circuit during Qualifying and Racing.
3.2.	Retrieval of Karts is at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course
3.3.	Pit Crew must only enter the Circuit when permitted by the Grid Marshal or the Clerk of the Course and then only if wearing a HIGH VISIBILITY SAFETY VEST on the upper torso.
3.4.	Karts can be retrieved via In Grid
4.	ADDITIONAL VENUE REQUIREMENTS
4.1.	Subject to any applicable laws which may govern the access of animals, including but not limited to guide dogs, no animals are allowed anywhere within the facility.
4.2.	No dumping of fuel , please make your own arrangements. Tyres may be left in the tyre recycling bin near the nomination shed. Do not place tyres in rubbish bins.
4.3.	No unlicensed driving of motor vehicles permitted at the Circuit.
4.4.	No motorised scooters, mini bikes, roller blading, skateboards and tricycles allowed at the complex during the entire Meeting. Officials may confiscate any such items for the duration of the Meeting.
4.5.	Marquees are not to be erected without consent of the Club.
4.6.	NO FIRES are allowed at the RFKKC track at any time.
4.7.	Camping is permitted on Friday and Saturday nights. Please conserve your water usage as our track uses tank water. Please use your own generator to supply power to your pit area.
4.8.	The track will be open for pit and camping set-up from 7:30am Friday, 10 August.
4.9.	These Supplementary Regulations are to be read in conjunction with the 2018 JC Kart Series Supplementary Regulations.
