<p><b>Race Format</b></p>	<p>Each round will consist of 1 only 6 minute qualifying session, 3 heats and a Final.</p> <p>The system used for determining the grid positions at each round will be Format 2 as per the 2018 Permitted Systems of Gridding Club Competition.</p> <p>Number of laps will be as follows:</p> <p><b>All Classes:</b></p> <p>Emerald: Ht 1,2 - 10 laps, Ht3 - 12 laps, Final – 16 laps          Rockhampton: Ht 1,2 - 10 laps, Ht3 - 14 laps, Final – 16 laps          Gladstone: Ht 1,2 - 13 laps, Ht3 - 16 laps, Final – 18 laps          Bundaberg: Ht 1,2- 12 laps, Ht3 - 16 laps, Final – 18 laps</p>																								
<p><b>Race &amp; Series Points Calculation Method</b></p>	<p>Series point scores will be placed on the KA Queensland web site after each round</p> <p><b><u>CQ Series Points Method</u></b></p> <p>To determine the final placings for the CQ Series, points will be allocated from the overall results of each round.          All heats will count for overall points at each round.</p> <p><b><u>Series Points Calculation</u></b></p> <p>Round points calculation: All heats count. 0 points system</p> <p>Series points calculation:          Overall points for each round allocated as follows          eg. Field of 30 will have points awarded through to 25<sup>th</sup> place. <b>Prizes</b>	<p>Trophies will be awarded for the 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> place at each race meeting. A minimum of 5 competitors required to be applicable for trophy.</p> <p>2018 Central Queensland Series trophies will be awarded to the 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> placing according to the points method calculated over all 4 rounds.</p> <p>Prizes will be offered by way of random draws at each round. Drivers must be present at the draw after trophy presentation to be eligible for the prizes.</p> <p>Each cadet 9 will be given an encouragement award to give positive feedback towards their efforts.</p> <p><b>Major end of series prizes will only be eligible for competitors who complete all four rounds of the JC kart CQ series.</b></p> <p><b><u>A total prize pool for the CQ Series shall be greater than \$35,000.</u></b></p>
