



Expenditure on Legal matters

General

From time to time the SKC may nominate a Solicitor to be the preferred company to provide legal advice to the Karting Queensland. Where this has been done, and where appropriate, the State Secretariat should direct all legal enquiries to that company.

At the time of adopting this policy, the AKA Karting Australia carries insurance that will cover the cost of defending legal action brought against the Karting Queensland its member clubs and officers and professional indemnity for the State Secretary

The insurance does not cover legal costs for action initiated by the Karting Australia or in the defence of criminal charges.

Delegated Authority

The State Secretariat has delegated authority to obtain legal advice on any sporting matter and where the cost to obtain that advice is expected to be less than \$1,000. Such advice is to be reported to the next State Karting Council meeting after the advice is obtained.

Where necessary, this advice can be provided in a closed session of the State Karting Council

State Karting Council Approval

State Karting Council approval is required before any legal action is initiated by the. Karting Queensland

State Karting Council approval is required for any legal expenditure on behalf of any member club or officer of the Karting Queensland

Before legal expenses are incurred, an estimate, by the Solicitors involved, of the total legal costs shall be obtained and reported to the State Karting Council.
