



## Technical Inspections

Officials who perform the duties of Technical Inspector at an Karting Queensland sanctioned race meeting are not permitted to inspect equipment that:

- (a) Is owned by the Technical inspector, or .
- (b) Is used by the Technical inspector, or
- (c) Is prepared by the Technical Inspector, or
- (d) Is used by a member of the Technical Inspector's immediate family.

Inspection of such equipment may be perceived to represent a conflict of interest on the part of the Technical Inspector.

Should a situation arise where such equipment is required for inspection, then the required inspections are to be conducted by an alternate accredited Technical Inspector already appointed under the race meeting permit.

Where there is not an alternate accredited Technical Inspector already appointed under the race meeting permit, another accredited Technical Inspector must be appointed by the Stewards of the meeting by way of bulletin, to perform the required inspections.

When neither of these options is available, the inspection may be completed by the appointed Technical Inspector in the presence of the competitor, his/her representative, or guardian in the case of a junior competitor, and the Clerk of Course.

This policy will defuse any innuendo that may arise against a Technical Inspector, where there may be the possibility of a perceived conflict of interest.
