



Track Inspections & License

Track Inspections are conducted in Queensland in Accordance with Karting Australia regulations and requirements.

The Track Licence fee covers one annual inspection. Any reinspection incurs an automatic cost of \$275 (Incl GST). State Championship inspections cost to be paid by KQ for clubs hosting the event.

Track Inspectors both Northern and Southern zone will inspect affiliated club circuits and make reports to the Executive of Karting Queensland and the Council.

A track inspector may not certify a track operated by a club of which the state track inspector is a member of. As per Chapter 4 section 3 (e) general rules circuit and track requirements.

Track Inspection reports will be signed off by the appropriate State Track Inspector (STI) and adopted by the Executive and or Council, work orders attached to the reports will be forwarded by the State Office to the affiliated clubs for completion by the duly advised approved dates. All completed work orders must have photos attached when returned to the State Secretary.

Completion of the work order dates will be advised in writing together with receipt notification of such work orders, which must be returned.

Clubs requesting extensions of work order dates must make an application to the State Office for approval by the Executive and or Council in writing supporting their case for an extension.

Completion of work order notices are to be signed off and reported as completed by only the Club President to the State Office on the Karting Queensland office issued notice. When the work order completion notices have been received in the State Office the Secretary of Karting Queensland will prepare, sign and issue the appropriate track licence for the current year with any conditions set as per regulation.

Clubs that do not complete their work orders by the due date and who have not sought extensions, or returned the completion sign off forms will not be issued race permits until the above items are completed.

A track which will be used for a State Championship (Bitumen or Dirt) must be inspected by the appropriate STI one month before the event to ensure its suitability for the forthcoming event.
