7.2.	If insufficient entries are received for a Class and/or Division to form in its own right, the Compulsory Competition Classes will be Consolidated in accordance with Competition Rules - Chapter 1, Rule 9. Discretionary Competition Classes may be Consolidated in accordance with the Rules or Cancelled at the discretion of the Organiser and in accordance with the Rules.

3. SPECIFIC COVID-19 RESTRICTION AND MITIGATION REQUIREMENTS

THE CLUB HAS COMPLETED A COVIDSafe ACTION PLAN

The Plan has been submitted to Karting Queensland and where required by law, to the relevant State Government Department. All actions identified as being required to be done to create a COVIDSafe Event and Club facility must be carried prior to and during the Event.

1.	PERMITTED AND NON-PERMITTED PERSONS
1.1.	No person who has symptoms consistent with COVID-19 (this includes any fever, respiratory symptoms, shortness of breath, sore throat, cough, lack of smell or fatigue) is permitted to attend the Circuit or participate in the Event.
1.2.	Any person who starts to feel unwell or to exhibit symptoms of COVID-19 during the Event must immediately avoid contact with all persons at the Circuit and MUST IMMEDIATELY LEAVE the Circuit.
1.3.	<p>Note – The Organising Club must ensure that the maximum number of people (the combined total of Essential Personnel and Permitted Persons) permitted to gather in total at an Event and in groups in accordance with State Public Health Authority Orders/Directions/Regulations is not exceeded at any time prior to or during the Event.</p> <p>Essential Karting Personnel is defined as:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Club President, Vice President, Treasurer, Secretary; and COVIDSafe Officer

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Essential Officials identified in Section 1.7 and 1.8 of these Regulations First Aid Attendant; and Administration and Access Control Attendant/s Event Operations staff (includes but is not limited to canteen staff, cleaners etc).
1.4.	<p>Permitted Persons</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> A Licensed Driver (Driver) who has booked their entry in the Event plus a maximum of Unlimited other people per kart who must be either: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The Parent, Legal Guardian, or family member of the Driver; or The Participant License Holder for the Driver; or A Mechanic whose sole task it is, is to prepare, adjust, repair the kart as may be required; A Person who is approved by the Club to supply karting components and provide specialised karting service to any Permitted Persons in attendance at the Activity.
1.5.	<p>Non-Permitted Persons</p> <p>SPECTATORS are permitted to be in attendance.</p>
2.	<p>SOCIAL DISTANCING AND DENSITY REQUIRMENTS (Note – the number chosen in 2.1 <u>must not exceed the maximum number of people permitted to gather under Government Directions.</u>)</p>
2.1.	Government prescribed Social Distancing measures must be observed at all times.
2.2.	The use by Permitted Persons of any indoor facilities is strictly limited by the Density Quotient of the room as included in the Club’s COVIDSafe Action Plan.
3.	<p>KARTING AUSTRALIA COVID-19 DECLARATION</p> <p>3.1 Under NO circumstances is ANYONE who has been overseas, or in a currently declared COVID-19 hotspot, in the previous 14 days or been in contact with a person who is known to be COVID-19 positive, permitted to attend the Circuit.</p> <p>All Essential Karting Personnel and Permitted Persons MUST complete the compulsory State Government issued QR Code Check-In before the commencement time of the Activity.</p>
4.	<p>HYGIENE FACILITIES - TOILET/WASHROOM FACILITIES and HAND SANITISER</p>
4.1	The Club is required to provide facilities to ensure general and sensible hygiene practices are maintained.
4.2	Toilet and washroom facilities at the Circuit must be open and available for use.
4.3	<p>Washroom facilities must be properly equipped with liquid soap, running water and either air hand driers or paper towels.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The toilets and washroom facilities must be cleaned at least once during the day or as otherwise required in accordance with the Club’s COVIDSafe Action Plan
4.4	It is strongly recommended that Essential Karting Personnel and Permitted Persons bring their own supply of hand sanitiser for use in accordance with government recommendations in addition to hand sanitiser that is supplied by the Club.

11.	TROPHIES & PRIZES					
11.1.	a)	<p>The results of the final race in each class or division at each round will determine the eligibility for prizes and awards. Point Score for Grid Procedure Unless otherwise specified in State Regulations, the point score outlined below will only be used to determine the grid for a heat and/or final race at a meeting. These points will not count towards the point score for prizes and awards. 1st: 0 points, 2nd: 2 points, 3rd: 3 points and son on with one (1) point being added for each place</p>				

Non-starters and non-finishers will be awarded a finishing position based on the number of laps completed. In instances of a tie this will be followed by the grid position awarded from the start of a heat.

In the event of a tie on points, the lower grid position will be awarded to the Driver with the fastest qualifying time or the highest finishing position in the previous heat.

Point Score

Unless otherwise specified in the State Regulations, the point score outlined below will be used for each Zonal Competition, if they are part of a series of events or a standalone event. These points will also count toward the point score for prizes and awards.

Points will be issued in accordance with the following table for qualifying, each heat and the final:

This point score will not be used to determine the grid for any heat or final race

In the event of a tie on points, the higher finishing position will be awarded to the Driver with the higher finishing position in the final.

Round Trophies / plaques will be awarded for the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place, and fastest qualifier, at each race meeting. Refer to individual supplementary regulations for each round for clarification of trophies. North Queensland Series Trophies will be awarded to the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd placing according to the points method calculated over all rounds based on minimum numbers being achieved (refer individual supplementary regulations) in each class. Classes must be run at every round to be eligible for series trophies. Prizes will be offered by way of random draws at each round. Drivers must be present at the draw after trophy presentation to be eligible for the prizes.

3.	KART RETRIEVAL
3.1.	Pit Crew with trolleys will not be given access to the Circuit during Qualifying and Racing.
3.2.	Retrieval of Karts is at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course
3.3.	Pit Crew must only enter the Circuit when permitted by the Grid Marshal and then only if wearing a HIGH VISIBILITY SAFETY VEST on the upper torso.
3.4.	Karts can be retrieved via Out Grid
4.	ADDITIONAL VENUE REQUIREMENTS
4.1.	Subject to any applicable laws which may govern the access of animals, including but not limited to guide dogs, no animals are allowed anywhere within the facility.
4.2.	No dumping of Fuel or Tyres, please make own arrangements.
4.3.	No unlicensed driving of motor vehicles permitted at the Circuit.
4.4.	No motorised scooters, mini bikes, roller blading, skateboards and tricycles allowed at the complex during the entire Meeting. Officials may confiscate any such items for the duration of the Meeting.
4.5.	Marquees are not to be erected without consent of the Club.
