Each Entry for this Meeting may be made using the KOMP as follows:
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Log on to your driver information via the Karting Australia Licencing and Events Portal or App Select the Event from the Event Calendar Enter the required details to complete your Event entry
Payment of the Entry Fee can be made via KOMP
CONDITIONS OF ENTRY: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Eligibility is limited to drivers who are holders of a current A, B or C Grade KA licence. D grade or provisional licence holders are not eligible to enter. Refusal or acceptance of entries is in accordance with General Rules, Chapter 1 Rule 17. The promoters reserve the right to abandon, postpone or cancel any event as in accordance with the Rules. NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED.

MINIMUM ENTRIES (Competition Rules, Chapter 5 Rule 4 l) If less than 10 genuine entries are received to constitute a Class by the listed close of entries, then the Class may NOT be contested. All drivers whose entry is not accepted for any Class shall be notified as soon as possible and entry fee will be returned. Class minimum numbers will need to be received by 1st June 2023 – This is essential for Trophy and Sponsor Commitments.

NOTICE BOARD ENTRY CONFIRMATION AT THE START OF THE RACE MEETING In lieu of an administrative checking session, an Official Entry List including transponder numbers will be posted on the Official Notice Board the afternoon of 29/06/2023. It is the responsibility of the Competitor to ensure that all information on the Official Entry List is correct. Any inaccuracies or discrepancies are required to be notified to the Chief Timekeeper no less than 60 minutes prior to the start of Practise for their respective Class.

*Proof of purchase receipts for the Fuel must be retained and produced to the Chief Scrutineer, State Technical Inspector or Fuel Tester as and when required.
Control Fuel <u>MUST</u> be used from Friday 30/06/2023 until the conclusion of the Meeting on Sunday 2/07/2023

*Random samples of Competitor's Fuel may be taken during the Meeting and tested for conformity to samples of the Control Fuel taken from the supplier on these dates. Competitors are reminded that Fuel tanks and drums should be empty prior to being used for Fuel purchased for this Meeting. No dumping of Fuel will be allowed on site.

GENERAL REGULATIONS**KART RETRIEVAL:**

Pit Crew with trolleys will NOT be given access to the Track during Qualifying and Racing. Retrieval is at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course.

Pit Crew must only enter the Track when permitted by the Grid Marshal and then only if wearing a **HIGH VISIBILITY SAFETY VEST** in accordance with the Rules.

Karts can be retrieved via access through the In/Out Grid only.

INSURANCE:

Has been effected for this Meeting in accordance with General Rules, Chapter 3 of the 2023 KA Manual.

SCRUTINEERING:

Scrutineering for this Meeting will be in accordance with Technical Rules, Chapter 6 of the 2023 KA Manual.

In accordance with the provisions of the Technical Rules, Chapter 6 of the 2023 KA Manual, each Kart shall have affixed to it a correct scrutineering sticker or identifying mark supplied for the Meeting. This signifies that the Driver has confirmed their entry for the Meeting and completed a Scrutineering Form relevant to the Entry.

As from Friday 30th June, the Grid Marshal / Scrutineers shall not allow any Kart that does not display a correct scrutineering sticker or identifying mark to Practice, Qualify or Race. Failure to comply will result in the Driver being excluded from the Meeting.

FRONT FAIRING (Technical Rules, Chapter 1 Rule 8 g) (iii):

The Front Fairing Fitment Rules Will Not be used at this Meeting.

ENGINE SEALING AND CHASSIS TAGGING:

Each engine and Chassis must be sealed and tagged in accordance with the provisions of Technical Rules, Chapter 6.

TIMING TRANSPONDER FITTING INSTRUCTIONS:

MYLAPS compatible transponders must be mounted in accordance with Technical Rules, Chapter 1 Rule 8 i)

Note: All Karts **MUST** have fitted and correctly charged and operating transponders for all sessions commencing 30/06/2023

VEHICLE / TRAILER ACCESS:

Trailer access will be available from Thursday June 29th. All vehicles not incorporated into a pit space must be removed from the pit area.

SECURITY:

Security will be provided Thursday, Friday and Saturday nights.

No unauthorised access will be provided outside Gate Opening Times.

VIDEO RECORDING SYSTEM:

Recording Medium (SD Card) Procedures

- a) It is compulsory for all Competitors to fit a camera to their Kart in a working condition from the start of the first practice session at each Meeting. Failure to do so will result in Disqualification of the Competitor from the next practice session. In the event of it being the final practice session of the day the Competitor will start from the rear of the grid in Qualifying.
- b) A separate SD Card must be used for each Class contested at a Meeting.
- c) Prior to the commencement of on-track activity on each day of a Round, the Recording Medium used in the camera fitted to a Kart must be completely cleared and reformatted.
- d) No recorded vision on the Recording Medium may be deleted from the time that on-track activity has commenced on each day of a Meeting until 0700 hours the next day, without the prior written permission of the Stewards.

FURTHER NOTES:

- **Subject to any applicable laws which may govern the access of animals, including but not limited to guide dogs, no animals are allowed anywhere within the facility.**
- No unlicensed driving of motor vehicles permitted at the Circuit.
- No motorised scooters, mini bikes, roller blading, skateboards, bicycles and tricycles allowed at the complex during the entire Meeting. Officials may confiscate any such items for the duration of the event.
- The Club does have EFTPOS facilities available trackside.
- **Camping Will Not be available at the event.**
