3.1.	Pit Crew with trolleys Will be given access to the Circuit during Qualifying and Racing.
3.2.	Retrieval of Karts is at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course
3.3.	Pit Crew must only enter the Circuit when permitted by the Grid Marshal or the Clerk of the Course and then only if wearing a HIGH VISIBILITY SAFETY VEST on the upper torso.
3.4.	Karts can be retrieved via In grid, after authorization from Clerk and Grid Marshal
4.	ADDITIONAL VENUE REQUIREMENTS
	Pets are permitted into Suncity Raceway during the prescribed race meet, All pets are to be contained within trailer
4.1.	area. Participants that have pets are to use the grass area only. PETS ARE NOT PERMITTED WITHIN THE PIT AREAS
