6.	MINIMUM ENTRIES
6.1	4 is the minimum number of pre entries which must be received for each Class and/or Division.
6.2	If insufficient entries are received for a Class and/or Division to form in its own right, the Compulsory Competition Classes will be Consolidated in accordance with Competition Rules - Chapter 1, Rule 9. Discretionary Competition Classes may be Consolidated in accordance with the Rules or Cancelled at the discretion of the Organiser and in accordance with the Rules.
6.3	If a Class or Division is cancelled, the Entry Fee may be refunded at the discretion of the Organiser and in accordance with the Rules.

2.	Practice 2 Practice session/s of 8 minutes minimum will be held.
3.	Qualifying There will be Timed Qualifying at this Event. There will be one (1) standalone Qualifying session of 6 minutes ** KA3 Junior Heavy TOP 5 SHOOTOUT ** The top 5 qualifiers will go into a shootout immediately after timed qualifying. 5 th fastest from the timed qualifying session will go out first, 4 th fastest will go second & so on with top qualifier going last. The results from the top 5 shootout will set the grid as per race format 2. The order of Karts on the grid for the commencement of Qualifying must be random – no high/low numbers)
4.	Heats & Final The system of gridding will be in accordance with State Regulations - Zonal Competition Format 2 (NOTE: ONLY ONE OF THE FORMATS 1-12 ARE PERMITTED TO BE USED)

3.1.	Pit Crew with trolleys will not be given access to the Circuit during Qualifying and Racing.
3.2.	Retrieval of Karts is at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course
3.3.	Pit Crew must only enter the Circuit when permitted by the Grid Marshal and then only if wearing a HIGH VISIBILITY SAFETY VEST on the upper torso.
3.4.	Karts can be retrieved via Out Grid
4.	ADDITIONAL VENUE REQUIREMENTS
4.1.	Subject to any applicable laws which may govern the access of animals, including but not limited to guide dogs, no animals are allowed anywhere within the facility.
4.2.	No dumping of Fuel or Tyres, please make own arrangements.
4.3.	No unlicensed driving of motor vehicles permitted at the Circuit.
4.4.	No motorised scooters, mini bikes, roller blading, skateboards and tricycles allowed at the complex during the entire Meeting. Officials may confiscate any such items for the duration of the Meeting.
