2.1.	Essential Karting Personnel and Permitted Persons are not permitted to gather in groups greater than 100 while in attendance at the Event.			
2.2.	Government prescribed Social Distancing measures must always be observed.			
2.3.	The use by Permitted Persons of any indoor facilities is strictly limited by the Density Quotient of the room as included in the Club's COVIDSafe Action Plan.			
2.4.	<ul> <li>Food service provided at the Event must fully comply with all State Public Health Authority Orders/Directions/Regulations.</li> <li>Hand Hygiene must be available at all food service outlets.</li> <li>Regular cleaning in accordance with the Club's COVIDSafe Action Plan MUST be carried out throughout the Event.</li> </ul>			
3.	HYGIENE FACILITIES - TOILET/WASHROOM FACILITIES and HAND SANITISER
