

3.	KART RETRIEVAL
3.1.	Pit Crew with trolleys Will be given access to the Circuit during Qualifying and Racing.
3.2.	Retrieval of Karts is at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course
3.3.	Pit Crew must only enter the Circuit when permitted by the Grid Marshal or the Clerk of the Course and then only if wearing an ORANGE HIGH VISIBILITY SAFETY VEST on the upper torso. It is the responsibility of Pit Crew to have their

	own Orange High Visibility Safety Vest. It is an offence to wear a Karting Australia Officials Vest, Refer General Rules, Chapter 8, Rule 5 m) (i) unless you are an official of the event.
3.4.	Karts can be retrieved via the Out Grid with the permission of the Grid Marshall.
4.	ADDITIONAL VENUE REQUIREMENTS
4.1.	Subject to any applicable laws which may govern the access of animals, including but not limited to guide dogs, no animals are allowed anywhere within the facility.
4.2.	No dumping of Fuel or Tyres, please make your own arrangements.
4.3.	No unlicenced driving of motor vehicles permitted at the circuit.
4.4.	No motorised scooters, mini bikes, roller blading, skateboards, scooters, bicycles and tricycles allowed at the complex during the entire Meeting. Officials may confiscate any such items for the duration of the Meeting.
4.5.	Marquees are not to be erected without consent of the Club.
4.6.	It is an offence to move a trolley carrying a kart, while the engine of the kart is running. Refer General Rules, Chapter 4, Rule 20
4.7.	Only the Driver and 2 pit crew are permitted on the out grid
