Rules for Thong Throw: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Competitor must be dressed in all safety gear except helmet• Each competitor will receive a rubber thong with their race number on it• Each competitor throws the thong (in any fashion they wish) from the throw line (one at a time). The competitors foot must stay behind the throw line during the throw.• Finishing positions will be determined by the length of the throw with the rubber thong landing furthest as determined the winner and 2nd furthest being in 2nd and so on and so forth. Judge of fact will be timekeepers for the event

3.3.	Pit Crew must only enter the Circuit when permitted by the Grid Marshal or the Clerk of the Course and then only if wearing a HIGH VISIBILITY SAFETY VEST on the upper torso.
3.4.	Karts can be retrieved via In grid, after authorization from Clerk and Grid Marshal
4.	ADDITIONAL VENUE REQUIREMENTS
4.1.	Subject to any applicable laws which may govern the access of animals, including but not limited to guide dogs, no animals are allowed anywhere within the facility.
4.2.	No dumping of Fuel or Tyres, please make your own arrangements.
4.3.	No unlicensed driving of motor vehicles permitted at the Circuit.
4.4.	No motorised scooters, mini bikes, roller blading, skateboards, bicycles and tricycles allowed at the complex during the entire Meeting. Officials may confiscate any such items for the duration of the Meeting.
