The use by Permitted Persons of any indoor facilities is strictly limited by the Density Quotient of the room as included 2.2. in the Club's COVIDSafe Action Plan. 2.3. Food service provided at the Event must fully comply with all State Public Health Orders/Directions/Regulations. Hand Hygiene must be available at all food service outlets. Regular cleaning in accordance with the Club's COVIDSafe Action Plan MUST be carried out throughout the Event. HYGIENE FACILITIES - TOILET/WASHROOM FACILITIES and HAND SANITISER 4. 4.1 The Club is required to provide facilities to ensure general and sensible hygiene practices are maintained. 4.2 Toilet and washroom facilities at the Circuit must be open and available for use. Washroom facilities must be properly equipped with liquid soap, running water and either air hand driers or paper towels. 4.3 The toilets and washroom facilities must be cleaned at least once during the day or as otherwise required in accordance with the Club's COVIDSafe Action Plan It is strongly recommended that Essential Karting Personnel and Permitted Persons bring their own supply of hand 4.4 sanitiser for use in accordance with government recommendations in addition to hand sanitiser that is supplied by the

3.	KART RETRIEVAL
3.1.	Pit Crew with trolleys Will be given access to the Circuit during Qualifying and Racing.
3.2.	Retrieval of Karts is at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course
3.3.	Pit Crew must only enter the Circuit when permitted by the Grid Marshal or the Clerk of the Course and then only if wearing a <b>HIGH VISIBILITY SAFETY VEST</b> on the upper torso.
3.4.	Karts can be retrieved via retrieval vehicle – drop off – In grid area
4.	ADDITIONAL VENUE REQUIREMENTS
4.1.	Pets are permitted into Suncity Raceway during the prescribed race meet, All pets are to be contained within trailer area. Participants that have pets are to use the grass area only. PETS ARE NOT PERMITTED WITHIN THE PIT AREAS INCLUDING THE TRAILER PARK, IN GRID OR OUT GRID.
4.2.	No dumping of Fuel or Tyres, please make your own arrangements.
4.3.	No unlicenced driving of motor vehicles permitted at the Circuit.
4.4.	No motorised scooters, mini bikes, roller blading, skateboards, bicycles and tricycles allowed at the complex during the entire Meeting. Officials may confiscate any such items for the duration of the Meeting.
