3.	KART RETRIEVAL
3.1.	Pit Crew with trolleys Will be given access to the Circuit during Qualifying and Racing.
3.2.	Retrieval of Karts is at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course
3.3.	Pit Crew must only enter the Circuit when permitted by the Grid Marshal or the Clerk of the Course and then only if wearing a <b>HIGH VISIBILITY ORANGE SAFETY VEST</b> on the upper torso.
3.4.	Karts can be retrieved via gates as directed by Clerk of Course or the Grid Marshal
4.	ADDITIONAL VENUE REQUIREMENTS
4.1.	Subject to any applicable laws which may govern the access of animals, including but not limited to guide dogs, no animals are allowed anywhere within the facility.
4.2.	No dumping of Fuel or Tyres, please make your own arrangements.
4.3.	No unlicenced driving of motor vehicles permitted at the Circuit.
4.4.	No motorised scooters, mini bikes, roller blading, skateboards, bicycles and tricycles allowed at the complex during the entire Meeting. Officials may confiscate any such items for the duration of the Meeting.
4.5.	Marquees are not to be erected without consent of the Club.
4.6.	No engines are to be started before 8.00am or after 5.00pm
4.7.	Camping is available and can only be booked online through <a href="https://www.warwickkartclub.com.au/pay">www.warwickkartclub.com.au/pay</a> and prior to arrival at the circuit.
4.8.	Limited onsite power is available but not during racing time periods (7.00am – 5.00pm)
